Update on Police Cruiser and Car Involved in Crash

Hingham, MA – The driver, K9 Officer and K9 were all treated and released after this crash.

Investigation shows K9 Officer Ryan Ross was responding on to a roll over crash on Kilby St. with his emergency lights and siren on. As he traveled on Route 3A (Lincoln St.) near #300 heading east he began to pass a car traveling in the same direction that was in the left lane by moving into the oncoming lane. As he did so, that car began making a left turn into the path of the cruiser. The left front of the car struck the right front of the cruiser. The impact sent the cruiser into the curb and over a signpost.

The driver of the car, a 22 Hingham woman, was transported to the hospital. Her two passengers, an 18 year old Hingham man and a 21 Quincy man, were not injured. Officer Ross was transported to the hospital. K9 Pedy was taken to a veterinarian, examined, and released. The driver and Officer Ross were treated and released at the hospital.

Both vehicles, a 2008 Hyundai Accent and a 2018 Ford Explorer Police Interceptor, were towed. The driver of the Hyundai was issued a citation (warning) for Improper Left Turn and Failure to Move Over for an Emergency Vehicle.

Police Cruiser and Car Involved in Crash

Hingham, MA – A Hingham Police cruiser was involved in a crash today with another vehicle. The crash sent a motorist, a K9 Officer and a police K9 to the hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

On Saturday June 8, 2019 at approximately 4:00 K9 Officer Ryan Ross was responding to a report of a roll over crash when his cruiser was involved in a crash on Lincoln St. (Route 3A). As a result of the crash, the driver of the car and K9 Officer Ross were transported to the hospital. Officer Ross's partner, K9 Pedy, was also taken to a veterinarian for examination.

Both vehicles towed from the scene. The crash remains under investigation.
